4 TYPES OF BELIEVERS IN TROUBLE

STARVING CHRISTIANS

Psalm 107:1-5 KJV

- 1 O give thanks unto the Lord, for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- 2 Let the redeemed of the Lord say so, whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy;
- 3 And gathered them out of the lands, from the east, and from the west, from the north, and from the south. 4 They wandered in the wilderness in a solitary way; they found no city to dwell in.
- 5 Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them.

Hebrews 10:25 KJV

25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Psalm 107:6-7 KJV

- 6 Then they cried unto the Lord in their trouble, and he delivered them out of their distresses.
- 7 And he led them forth by the right way, that they might go to a city of habitation.

THE BELIEVER WHO HAS FALLEN INTO SIN BECAUSE OF DISOBEDIENCE

Psalm 107:10-12 New International Version

- 10 Some sat in darkness, in utter darkness, prisoners suffering in iron chains,
- 11 because they rebelled against God's commands and despised the plans of the Most High.
- 12 So he subjected them to bitter labor; they stumbled, and there was no one to help.

BELIEVERS ACTING LIKE FOOLS BRINGING PROBLEMS ON THEMSELVES

Psalm 107:17-18 New International Version

- 17 Some became fools through their rebellious ways and suffered affliction because of their iniquities.
- 18 They loathed all food and drew near the gates of death.

Psalm 107:19 New International Version

19 Then they cried to the Lord in their trouble, and he saved them from their distress.

BELIEVER WHO IS OVERWHELMED BY PROBLEMS

Psalm 107:23-27 New International Version

23 Some went out on the sea in ships; they were merchants on the mighty waters. 24 They saw the works of the Lord, his wonderful deeds in the deep. 25 For he spoke and stirred up a tempest that lifted high the waves. 26 They mounted up to the heavens and went down to the depths; in their peril their courage melted away. 27 They reeled and staggered like drunkards; they were at their wits' end.

Psalm 106:43-44 New International Version

- 43 Many times he delivered them, but they were bent on rebellion and they wasted away in their sin.
- 44 Yet he took note of their distress when he heard their cry;
