What is the purpose of the Lord allowing storms to come into our lives?

3 reasons:

- → Demonstrates that God has supreme power over everything
- → Strengthens the belief of his followers

→All come to know that he can deliver us no matter what problems we encounter

Mark 4:35-37 King James Version

- 35 And the same day, when the even was come, he saith unto them, Let us pass over unto the other side.
 36 And when they had sent away the multitude, they took him even as he was in the ship. And there were also with him other little ships.
- 37 And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full.

Jesus had been preaching and teaching all day to a large group of people (Mark 4:1)

JESUS WAS TIRED!!

(notice the language used in the Bible...." they took him even as he was")

Another key detail: the Bible mentions there are other ships in the water following Jesus and the disciples

(they will be witnesses to what is about to happen)

This is when a great storm arrives

Romans 13:12 King James Version

12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.

- 2 Timothy 4:2 King James Version
- 2 Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all long suffering and doctrine.

Mark 4:38 King James Version

38 And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish?

In the midst of this great storm, Jesus is sleeping

HOW MANY TIMES HAVE PROBLEMS ENTERED YOUR LIFE WHEN YOU WERE EXHAUSTED??

Matthew 8:24 King James Version

24 And, behold, there arose a great tempest in the sea, insomuch that the ship was covered with the waves: but he was asleep.

Luke 8:23 King James Version

23 But as they sailed he fell asleep: and there came down a storm of wind on the lake; and they were filled with water, and were in jeopardy.

These details are here to illustrate just how severe the storm was


Psalm 32:6 King James Version

6 For this shall every one that is godly pray unto thee in a time when thou mayest be found: surely in the floods of great waters they shall not come nigh unto him. No matter how severe a storm is, peace and calm can be experienced during dark times!!

The Bible makes reference to the "sea" being the Sea of Galilee

about 13 miles long and 8 miles wide





CAN WE BE AT PEACE AS CHRIST WAS??

Psalm 34:18 King James Version

18 The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.

1 John 5:4-5 King James Version

- 4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.
- 5 Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

How did the disciples respond?

THE SAME WAY WE ALL PROBABLY WOULD!!!

Remember, the disciples were seasoned fisherman

They had been through storms before

So what made this time so different?

THEY CONFESSED THEIR INABILITY TO SOLVE

THE PROBLEM BY THEMSELVES

THEY, AND WE, NEEDED GOD'S HELP!!!

Mark 4:39 King James Version

39 And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

Notice the order of action:

"arose....rebuked.....said..."

"Peace be still" is translated to literally mean "be muzzled"

Once again, Jesus showing his total power over all of creation

2 Corinthians 2:14 King James Version

14 Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.

2 Timothy 4:18 King James Version

18 And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

- 2 Corinthians 1:3-4 King James Version
- 3 Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort;
- 4 Who comforteth us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God.

Mark 4:40-41 King James Version

- 40 And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith?
- 41 And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?

The disciples feel greater fear on a calm sea w/Jesus, than when the storm was raging


HATE PEACE AND QUIET??

HOW MANY PEOPLE DO YOU KNOW THAT LOVE CHAOS AND CONFUSION???

Mark 5:1-5 King James Version

- 1 And they came over unto the other side of the sea, into the country of the Gadarenes.
- 2 And when he was come out of the ship, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit,
- 3 Who had his dwelling among the tombs; and no man could bind him, no, not with chains:

- 4 Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any man tame him.
- 5 And always, night and day, he was in the mountains, and in the tombs, crying, and cutting himself with stones.



When we think of a lake or sea, we usually imagine a calm, soothing, peaceful place

NOT TODAY!!!!!

The demon possessed man represents the world that loves everything God hates

Evil thoughts/actions/deeds/words/environment

John 3:19 King James Version

19 And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

Ephesians 2:2-3 King James Version

- 2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:
- 3 Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

This man was an outcast from society, making his home in among the dead

Jesus spoke the words of power

revealed the man's great need

revealed the enemies true nature

Mark 5:14-15 King James Version

- 14 And they that fed the swine fled, and told it in the city, and in the country. And they went out to see what it was that was done.
- 15 And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

The herd of swine destroyed

unclean sprits into unclean animals

The man delivered and in his right mind..... WHAT A MIRACLE!!!

Ephesians 3:20 King James Version

20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,

And they that fed the swine fled..."

→ Swine keepers ran to tell the swine owners about what had just happened, because they didn't want to get blamed


THERE WAS A FINANCIAL COST TO LOSING THE SWINE!!!

Those that saw what happened tell both sides of the story





Can you imagine what his family and friends must have said when they saw him??


