From early 1st century society until right now, the world has done everything in its power to shame/mock/disparage Christianity

WE ARE STILL STANDING IN THE GAP!!!!

Acts 5:12-16 King James Version

- 12 And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people; (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch.
- 13 And of the rest durst no man join himself to them: but the people magnified them.
- 14 And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.)

- 15 Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them.
- 16 There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.



1. SIGNS AND WONDERS

→ The world doesn't understand Jesus' saving grace or miraculous healing

Miracles show the ignorance and inability of man

Miracles show there is a higher being than man, to whom man must submit

Miracles disturb people and reminds them of their great need

2. GREAT UNITY

The world fears when we come together for prayer, and when we are united in purpose and mission

REACHING OUT TO EVANGELIZE/ATTRACTING CROWDS

SPEAK — COURAGEOUSLY AND BOLDLY

IS THIS EASY ???

NO!!!!!

DIFFICULT ASSIGNMENTS USUALLY FOLLOW MIRACLES

THERE ARE HEAVY RESPONSIBILITIES ASSIGNED TO THOSE WHO'VE HAD MIRACLES DONE TO THEM

Acts 5:21-25 King James Version

- 21 And when they heard that, they entered into the temple early in the morning, and taught. But the high priest came, and they that were with him, and called the council together, and all the senate of the children of Israel, and sent to the prison to have them brought.
- 22 But when the officers came, and found them not in the prison, they returned and told,

- 23 Saying, The prison truly found we shut with all safety, and the keepers standing without before the doors: but when we had opened, we found no man within. 24 Now when the high priest and the captain of the temple and the chief priests heard these things, they doubted of them whereunto this would grow.
- 25 Then came one and told them, saying, Behold, the men whom ye put in prison are standing in the temple, and teaching the people.

The "council" is shocked.....how could these men escape???

Even more shocking.....the apostles didn't run away like escaped convicts!!

THE BEHAVIOR OF TRUE BELIEVERS IN PERSECUTION WILL ALWAYS CONFUSE THE PERSECUTORS!!!!

1 Peter 4:12-13 King James Version

- 12 Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you:
- 13 But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings; that, when his glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy.

1 Peter 5:10 King James Version

10 But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you.

Acts 5:27-28 King James Version

- 27 And when they had brought them, they set them before the council: and the high priest asked them,
- 28 Saying, Did not we straitly command you that ye should not teach in this name? and, behold, ye have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this man's blood upon us.

The charges brought against the apostles amount to:

- → breaking the law
- → teaching a false doctrine
- → falsely accusing the government of murder

NOTE HOW THE TRUTH MATTERED LITTLE TO THESE "LEADERS"

HOW LITTLE DO THEY MATTER TO YOUR PERSECUTORS!!!!

THEY HAD KILLED JESUS, AND ACCEPTED RESPONSIBILITY FOR IT!!!!

Matthew 27:25 King James Version 25 Then answered all the people, and said, His blood be on us, and on our children.

HOW WOULD YOU RESPONSD TO THESE ALLEGATIONS??

HOW DID THE APOSTLES RESPOND???

Acts 5:29-32 King James Version

29 Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men. **30** The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree. 31 Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. 32 And we are his witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him.

Loyalty and obedience to GOD, not man

Christ died a criminals' death, the one we deserved (Deut 21:22-23)

Jesus is a Prince and Savior who gives repentance and forgiveness

He made the apostles and all of us witnesses to these things

Hebrews 2:3-4 King James Version

- 3 How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him;
- 4 God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will?

John 15:26-27 King James Version

- 26 But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:
- 27 And ye also shall bear witness, because ye have been with me from the beginning.

THEY EVIL HEARTS WANTED TO KILL THE APOSTLES, THERE WAS NO REASON OR RATIONAL THINKING

ONE OF THE 7 SINS THAT GOT HATES!!!!
(HEARTS THAT DEVISETH WICKED PLANS)

Acts 5:34-42 King James Version

- 34 Then stood there up one in the council, a Pharisee, named Gamaliel, a doctor of the law, had in reputation among all the people, and commanded to put the apostles forth a little space;
- 35 And said unto them, Ye men of Israel, take heed to yourselves what ye intend to do as touching these men.

36 For before these days rose up Theudas, boasting himself to be somebody; to whom a number of men, about four hundred, joined themselves: who was slain; and all, as many as obeyed him, were scattered, and brought to nought. 37 After this man rose up Judas of Galilee in the days of the taxing, and drew away much people after him: he also perished; and all, even as many as obeyed him, were dispersed.

38 And now I say unto you, Refrain from these men, and let them alone: for if this counsel or this work be of men, it will come to nought: 39 But if it be of God, ye cannot overthrow it; lest haply ye be found even to fight against God. 40 And to him they agreed: and when they had called the apostles, and beaten them, they commanded that they should not speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go.

- 41 And they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for his name.
- 42 And daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ.

A new character is introduced: Gamaliel

Who was this man?

One of the most well respected rabbis and Pharisees

→ He was also the teacher of Saul, who became Paul (Acts 22:3)

WHAT IS HIS COUNSEL??

The disciples are beaten, but not killed

They felt honor and joy to suffer for Jesus' name

Proverbs 29:1 King James Version

29 He, that being often reproved hardeneth his neck, shall suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy.
