A famous story awaits us, filled with extremely valuable lessons to be learned Luke 18:9 King James Version 9 And he spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others:

Christ identifies and directs the beginning of this parable to (3) types of self-centered people

Those who trust in themselves, are selfsufficient, and have no need for anyone else



1 Corinthians 8:2 King James Version
2 And if any man think that he knoweth any thing, he knoweth nothing yet as he ought to know. Galatians 6:3 King James Version 3 For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself. Proverbs 26:12 King James Version 12 Seest thou a man wise in his own conceit? there is more hope of a fool than of him. Those who are self-righteous. This differs from self-sufficient, and falls into 2 categories

Those who feel they're good enough for God as they are

They believe God won't reject them no matter what

They know they do wrong but enough good will "makeup" for it

MOST PEOPLE FALL INTO THIS CATEGORY!!!!!

Those who are self-conscience and feel the need to do good works

They feel "good works" will secure the favor of God

They feel "good works" are what make them good and righteous

GOD CAN'T BE BOUGHT OR BRIBED!!!

Matthew 5:20 King James Version 20 For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Romans 3:20 King James Version 20 Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin. **2 Timothy 1:9 King James Version** 9 Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,

Those who despise others

Pharisee:

→ Strictest religious sect of the day

\rightarrow He was expected to be there

→ He came to the temple with the wrong motivation.....

TO IMPRESS

HOW MANY PEOPLE COME TO CHURCH LOOKING TO IMPRESS?

CHURCH IS NOT NEW YORK FASHION WEEK!!!!!!

Publican:

- \rightarrow Tax collector
- → Despised by his own people, considered a traitor
- → He had no doubt or illusions about his own sins and faults

BOTH MEN CAME TO CHURCH TO SEEK GOD!!!!

THEY WERE IN THE RIGHT PLACE AT THE RIGHT TIME!!!!

Luke 18:11-12 King James Version **11 The Pharisee stood and prayed** thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. 12 I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess.

A 34-WORD PRAYER.....

5 OF THOSE WORDS ARE "I"

HOW MANY PEOPLE DO YOU KNOW THAT LOVE TO PUT ON A PERFORMANCE???

Where was his worship?

Where was his communion?

John 9:31 (KJV)

31 Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth.

Proverbs 28:9 (KJV)

9 He that turneth away his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer shall be abomination.

Micah 3:4 (KJV)

4 Then shall they cry unto the Lord, but he will not hear them: he will even hide his face from them at that time, as they have behaved themselves ill in their doings.

His reason for feeling righteous?? "....I am not as other men are....."

He thanked God specifically for keeping him from public/scandalous sins

Specifically calling out extortioner/adulterer/betrayer/unjust

To top it all off, he mentions his fasting ritual and tithe giving

Christ condemns fasting when it is seen as a way of meriting God's favor, or when publicized through boasting display

This Pharisee boasts about exceeding God's law when it comes to fasting and tithing

Luke 18:13-14 (KJV)

13 And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. 14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

Evidence of humility and repentance

He "stood off" because of the shame/embarrassment/isolation he felt

He wouldn't "lift up" his eyes to heaven because of the guilt in his heart, and not feeling worthy of forgiveness He "smote upon his breast" showing his internal anger and disappointment towards himself

James 4:10 (KJV)

10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.

Psalm 34:18 (KJV)

18 The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.

Isaiah 57:15 (KJV)

15 For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.
